<b>Understanding of UN SDGs</b>	Students do not refer to the UN SDGs.	Students mention UN SDGs but there is no connection to their CAS project.	Students link their CAS Project to UN SDGs. <b>Originality of Project Idea</b>	The idea did not show originality, and the CAS Project has been done in the past.	Students use an existing idea and execute it in a new way. Students went above and beyond, showing creativity, original thinking, and a strategic approach.
<b>Project Execution</b>	Students did not execute the project idea.	Students say they executed the project but there is no proof.	Students executed the project as planned.	Students executed the project with extra effort.	Students executed their project strategically, measuring success throughout (using SMART goals).
<b>Project Impact</b>	Students cannot show the impact their CAS Project had.	Students show that their CAS Project had very little impact. Students showcase measurable and direct impact of their project on a local scale - with the ambition of continuing past the CAS Project Challenge submission.
<b>Presentation</b>	Students did not submit a video.	Students submitted a video, yet did not follow any of the guidelines.	Students submitted a video, yet did not follow all guidelines.	The video submitted follows all guidelines, incl. a maximum length of 180 seconds.	The students submitted a video that follows the guidelines, shows creativity, and is engaging for the viewer to watch.
