5 Day Amsterdam Itinerary

Day 1 – Arrival in Amsterdam

Activity	Description
Arrival and Transport to Accommodation	A dedicated local CAS Trips leader will greet the group at the airport before traveling to the accommodation.
Check-in and relax	Check-in, relax, and freshen up following the long journey
Walking Tour: Amsterdam's History and Culture	On this journey the group gets a chance to explore the network of streets, canals, and architecture through Amsterdam's world-famous city center. The local guide will share unique aspects of Amsterdam's history and lifestyle while visiting a few of the city's most famous sights.
Evening Meal	Enjoy international cuisine at the accommodation.

Day 2 – Creativity, Service

Activity	Description
Sustainable Design Challenge	This exciting hands-on challenge is where students' teamwork skills and creativity are put to the test. In small groups, participants look at local issues facing people they interview before working as a team to develop and present creative solutions.
Lunch	Organic meal at a quirky restaurant.
Service Challenge: Taste Before You Waste	In collaboration with a pioneering local NGO, students will hear about the impact of an organization combatting food waste in the city. In groups, the students will then team up to

collect, prep, and cook salvaged ingredients before serving the finished meals to members of the city's underprivileged communities.

Day 3 – Activity, Creativity

Activity	Description
Scenic Bike Tour	<p>There is nothing quite as Dutch as hopping on a bicycle and navigating the hundreds of kilometers of cycle paths to the charming villages around Amsterdam.</p> <p>On this stunning 3-hour bike ride for all abilities, the participants can take in the best of traditional Dutch culture through visiting windmills, canals, beautiful fields and picturesque villages.</p>

Lunch A packed lunch

Slow Fashion Runway Fast fashion is one of the biggest contributors to carbon emissions and global warming. In this sustainable fashion experience, groups will be challenged to shop within budget to put together an outfit while finding items to bring back home while learning how the methods of Reduce, Reuse, Recycle can look good and be affordable.

Day 4 – Service, Creativity

Activity	Description
Service Challenge: Plastic Fishing	<p>Departing on small electric boats with fishing nets in hand, students will not be catching fish, but will be collecting any plastic they see in the many canals of Amsterdam.</p>

The plastic 'caught' will be donated to a local organization who recycle it and build electric boats from the waste.

Traditional Dutch market lunch.

Famous Art Museum

Amsterdam celebrates its long and decorated fine art history with some of the best art museums in the world, including the Rijksmuseum, the Van Gogh Museum and Rembrandt Huis.

The school will pay a visit to a museum of their choice and experience world class art.

Reflection Workshop

Under the guidance of our CAS Trips Leaders, students participate in an in-depth reflection session to review the experiences and challenges of the trip. Developed to inspire participants, the workshop builds upon students' reflection skills that will be beneficial for the rest of their studies.

Activity	Description
CAS Project Challenge	<p>After an introduction to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals, students will receive the tools and framework to plan, organize, and engage in a long-term collaborative CAS Project that will have a positive impact on their own community.</p> <p>For IB students, this can be used as the basis of a CAS Project and for non-IB students, this is the perfect opportunity to ensure your experiences have a long-term positive effect back home.</p>
Souvenir Shopping	<p>Free time before departure will be offered to explore Amsterdam's world class shopping district in search of souvenirs and gifts to take home.</p>
Check-Out & Departure	<p>After picking up our luggage from the hotel, we will board the transportation back to the airport in time for your departure.</p>
