How will you track impact?

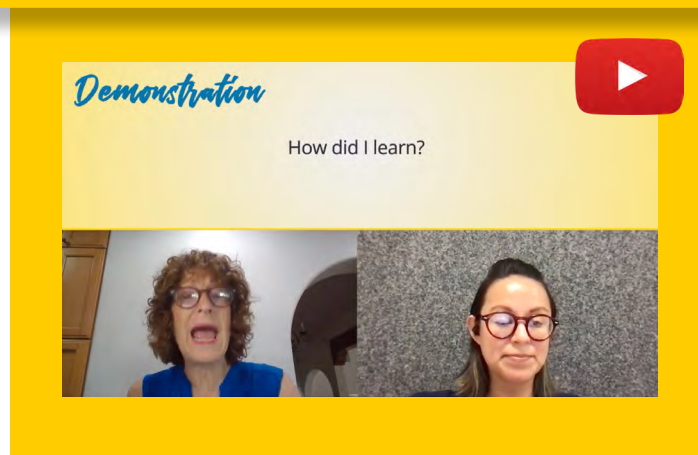
3.3 Demonstration
